1. Never again confess defeat, for: “God always causes us to triumph in Christ” (2 Cor. 2:14).
2. Never again confess bondage, for: “Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty” (2 Cor. 3:17).
3. Never again confess sickness, for: “With His stripes we are healed” (Isaiah 53:5) and “Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses” (Matthew 8:17).
4. Never again confess fear, for: “God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind” (2 Timothy 1:7) and “if God be for us who can be against us” (Romans 8:31).
5. Never again confess “I can’t”, for: “I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me” (Philippians 4:13).
6. Never again confess doubt and lack of faith, for: “God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith” (Romans 12:3) and “We having the same spirit of faith, we believe therefore we speak”. (2 Corinthians 4:13).
7. Never again confess poverty for: “My God supplies all my needs according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus”. Philippians 4:19.
8. Never again confess weakness, for: “The Lord is the strength of my life” (Psalms 27:1) and “The people that do know their God shall be strong and do exploits” (Daniel 11:32).
9. Never again confess Satan’s supremacy over your life, for: “Greater is He that is in you, than he that is in the world” (1John 4:4).
10. Never again confess a lack of wisdom, for: “But of Him are you in Christ Jesus, who of God us made unto us wisdom” (1Corinthians 1:30).
11. Never again confess feelings of guilt, for: “There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus” (Romans 8:1) and “As far as the east is from the west, so far hath He removed our transgressions from us” (Psalms 103:12).
12. Never again confess worry, for: “Do not fret or have anxiety about anything” (Philippians 4:6) and “Casting your care upon Him; for He cares for you” (1Peter 5:7).
13. Never again confess loneliness, for Jesus said: “I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee” (Hebrews 13:5) and “Lo, I am with you always, even unto the ends of the world” (Matthew 28:20).
14. Never again confess a fear of the future: “For I know the plans that I have for you, plans of good and not of evil that you may have a hope and future or expected end” (Jeremiah 29:11).
15. Never again confess an inability to conquer sin in your life: “For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death” (Romans 8:2).
16. Never again confess confusion, for: “Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given unto us of God” (1Corinthians 2:12) and “For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace” (1 Corinthians 14:33).
17. Never again confess failure, for: “Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us” (Romans 8:37).
